RAS INDIO STAYS POSITIVE WITH NEW C.D.

Music lovers will have one more album (CD) to add to their collection – Stay Positive from Ras Indio.

The new release will be on sale this week at your favourite record store countrywide. The fourteen songs combination contains selections such as the title track ‘Stay Positive’, ‘Rebel’ and ‘Equal Rights and Justice’ along with ‘Free Up Mi Nation’ along with others.

The latter two cuts written prior to the events of the Albert Street riot represents an excellent piece of foreshadow as it tells of struggles and eventual riots the Belizean people would sure to experience if they continue to be led by the ways of the present Government.

‘Free Up Mi Nation’ is a collaborative remix which features the artist’s older brother Ras Nkrumah.

For Ras Indio, this production represents another milestone in his seven year musical journey which dates back to the early days of the WoodDwellas, the first Belizean Group to have their own video.
